CSTEP trainings are FREE, multi-level and offered in English and Spanish.

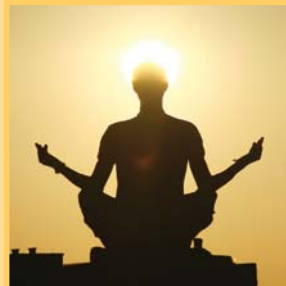
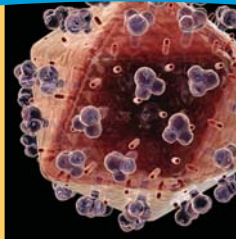
Basics: For people who are new to the field of HIV and those with limited backgrounds in biology and HIV.

Certification: For providers serving people with HIV or who are required to obtain a CSTEP certificate, such as Early Intervention Program staff.

Advanced: For HIV providers, such as treatment advocates and case managers who are seeking more in-depth HIV information.

Re-Certification: A fast-paced training that reviews topics discussed in CSTEP Certification and includes updated treatment information.

Up-To-Date: Designed to address emerging issues and varying topics useful to HIV providers.
