CSTEP Data gathered from 2000 to Present

CSTEP has trained nearly **2,000** participants in over **130** trainings throughout the state of California.

Table 1: Geographical Area of CSTEP Participants

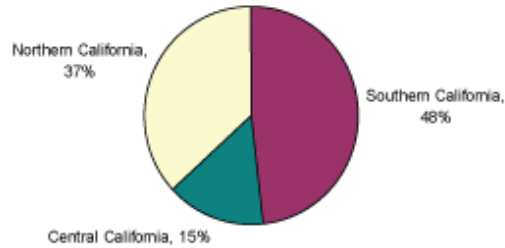


Table 1 illustrates that participants provide services in Northern California (37%), Southern California (48%) and Central California (15%) and Image 1 indicates cities where CSTEP trainings are held.

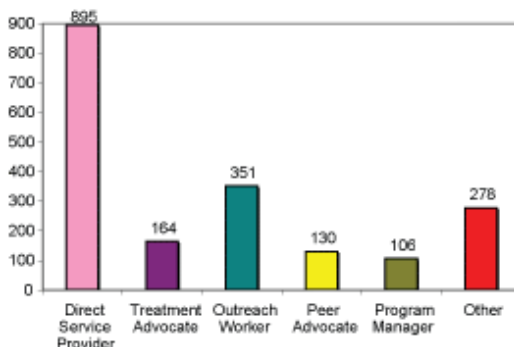
Image 1: CSTEP Training Sites



CSTEP's recent history (July 2006 to present) further demonstrates effectiveness:

- 90% of CSTEP participants received Treatment Educator certification or recertification in both English and Spanish.
- 100% of participants demonstrated an increase in knowledge
- 99.5% of participants self-assessed that CSTEP added to their knowledge and/or skills
- 99.0% indicated that the CSTEP training style encouraged active participation and interaction for optimal learning.

Additionally, 62% of participants work directly with people living with HIV/AIDS and 25% are focused on case finding and outreach services (See Table 2).

Table 3: CSTEP Participant Ethnicity

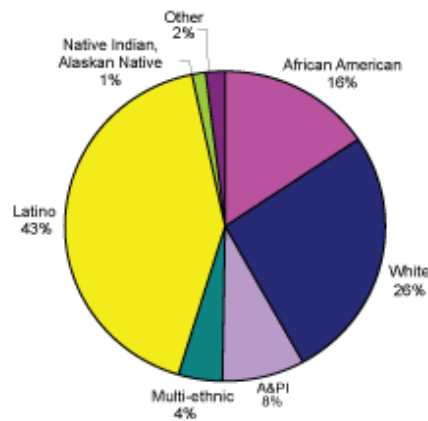


Table 3 shows 70% of all participants are people of color, predominantly from Latino (43%) and African American (16%) communities.
